Thank you for downloading **SafetyBarrierManager**

In order to run **SafetyBarrierManager**, extract the following files from the Zip archive to the **same** folder in your computer (it may be a USB drive, but it is best to run it from a fixed drive, because the registration key depends on the drive):

All DLL files:

- Libifcoremd.dll
- Libifportmd.dll
- Libmmd.dll
- Msjava.dll
- Msvcr80d.dll
- Safebarmanbdd.dll

The help files:

- SafeBar.chm

The executable:

- SafetyBarrierManager.exe

In order to run **SafetyBarrierViewer**, extract the following files from the Zip archive to the **same** folder in your computer (it may be a USB drive):

The help files:

- SafeBar.chm

The executable:

- SafetyBarrierViewer.exe

Please note that it is necessary to register with a license number to remove the restrictions of the unregistered version. For information about licensing, use the contact form available via [safetybarriermanager.com](http://safetybarriermanager.com). (The registration key depends on what drive you are running from – there are restrictions on how many drives you may run the program from)

The unregistered version is fully functional with following exceptions:

- There is a maximum of 15 conditions and 2 diagrams (when opening a file with more than 15 conditions or 2 diagrams it is not possible to edit the file)
- The text "unregistered" is displayed behind the diagrams.

Consult the help file in order to get started. The easiest way is to open an existing template. A zip set with sample diagram files can be downloaded from the download page.

Note that when running from the zip file, the file associations with the file types .sbmx and .sbmt will not work – but of course the program will be able to open and save project files with these extensions.
